MESSAGE TO PARENTS AND CARERS FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

Thank you to the parents who attended the Parent drop-in on Wednesday, or who sent in comments, for our discussion regarding homework. It was good to hear your thoughts and we will pass these back to staff. We have re-written our Homework Policy this year as we have made changes to the expectations we have of the children. Getting the balance of homework right is a tricky thing and we have not made any decisions lightly as we know there will be some parents who approve of the changes and some who don't but we are considering the needs currently of our children here at Maple Tree.

As a result of the changes made we are no longer sending home Learning Logs. The feedback that we got from children and parents is that whilst some really enjoyed these others found it time consuming and competitive. We will be setting short tasks according to the age and stage of the children. You will be able to see these expectations on the back page of this newsletter.

We are also very aware that times have changed since some of us were at school ourselves and processes may be different to how you learnt. There will be a letter sent out on Monday to parents of children in Key Stage 1 and 2 from Exemplar Education who are a company who offer online support in Mathematics and English. There will be a reply slip for you to fill in and return to school to show whether you are interested or not in further information from the company. If we receive 30% of the reply slips back, then they will give us 30 free site licences for the children to use in school – this would be a great resource for us to use with the children and at no cost to you or us which in this day and age is quite unusual! You do not even have to show a positive interest on the response form – you just need to send it back. Further details will be available to you in the letter that comes out on Monday. I really hope that you will take the time to send the reply slip back into school so we can all benefit from your responses.

If you have any questions regarding homework please do chat to your child's teacher. We do not want to quash the creativity of any child and should your child want to do something that matches the topic outside of school then we would, of course, love to see what they have done but this will be up to families to choose to do rather than having tasks set.

Our new Homework Policy will be on our website by half term for you to read and we will also start to use our class/year group pages on the website to share homework expectations with you as well.



Reception	5 minutes	In Reception, children are given lists of words to practise reading/sight recognition as word cards. Children will not be given written spellings to practise as in other years. Parents' are encouraged to support their children with these at home. To support maths, Reception children need to practise counting and recognising numbers. They may also need, when writing numerals, help to ensure they are written in the correct formation. The children also need to be aware of numbers around them so parents are encouraged to point these out in the environment when they see
		them. We do not expect them to do any formal written calculations but it would also benefit the children if they were encouraged to play counting games (board or otherwise).
Year 1	10 minutes	
Year 2	15 minutes	In Year 1, children will be given 5-10 spelling words, weekly to practise at home which are linked to sound patterns and high frequency words. They will be sent home weekly. In Years 2, children will be given 8-10 spelling words, weekly to practise at home. These will be linked to the spelling patterns and objectives they have been learning in spelling sessions. Spellings may also be linked to the high-frequency words or words from their spelling journal. To support their maths learning, KS1 will have Abacus practice set weekly — mainly in the form of games and will be expected to work on number bonds and times tables as appropriate.
Year 3	20 minutes	In Years 3- 4, children will be given 8-15 spelling words, weekly to practise
Year 4	25 minutes	at home. These will be linked to the spelling patterns and objectives they have been learning in spelling sessions. Spellings may also be linked to the high-frequency words or words from their spelling journal. KS2 will be set maths challenges on Sumdog and times tables practice weekly. At Key Stage 2 we continue to give children the sort of homework activities outlined above but we expect them to begin to do more tasks independently. As a general matter of course, reading or a reading activity will be continued on a daily basis.
