1:15am rain is still very heavy, pupils are passing my tent in a constant flow to visit the toilets, I am trying desperately to ignore the giggling and just sleep.

Wellies back on, umbrella up, coat soaking and patrolling outside the tents again at 2:35, just had to shout at pupils in two tents. They are up out of their sleeping bags talking at the top of their voices, I am amazed the neighbours haven't complained.

All is quiet, well not really, the A1 is very noisy, a train can be heard in the distance and someone is snoring! Just had to zip up my sleeping bag and put on a fleece, I am freezing and I think I have cramp in my right leg. It is 3:32am and every tent is silent, finally I can get some sleep.

5:21am and pupils are up again going back and forth to the toilet, we only gave them a cup of hot chocolate at 9pm **and** insisted they all went to the bathroom before they retired to their beds, sorry tents. Wellies back on, fleece still damp and off I go again appealing to their better natures. 'Please use your whisper voice, the rest of the world is still asleep.' Well not if you live near our school! Time to make a strong coffee, I feel it may be needed for the long day ahead.
