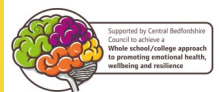
MESSAGE FROM THE HEAD

Message from Friends of Maple Tree

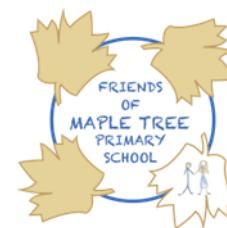
Following the AGM we can announce that the Committee Officers remain unchanged from last year. They are as follows:
