8 more get on and 3 get off.

How many people are on the bus now?

There are 25 beanbags.
Kim takes 11 and Amit takes 9.

How many beanbags are left?

There are 2 red buttons and 4 blue buttons on a card of buttons.

How many buttons are there on 10 cards?
